- ❖ Report card/Parent teacher conferences - great turn out.
- ❖ Spring has sprung and with it lots of outdoor fun. It means time to talk about year end planning and next year.
- ❖ We are looking forward to our school trip (grade primaries and ones) to Shubenacadie in May.
- ❖ RazzMatazz will be performing a bilingual concert in June for all students.
- ❖ Staffing allotment and class configurations- our numbers are not fully confirmed and we are waiting for official allocation but there will be an additional class in French Immersion this year, possibly an additional English one. We are planning a transition with the senior building for our grade 1s and primary orientation.
